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SAND TIGER SHARK



The Sand Tiger Shark is a large shark species with a unique appearance characterised by its protruding teeth and a sleek, sand-colored body.

DISTRIBUTION: Worldwide in subtropical/warm temperate waters.

MAXIMUM SIZE: 3.2 m

HABITAT: Shallow waters, sandy shallow bays, estuaries or rocky reefs. Can be found up to 200 m deep.
