



TIGER SHARK



The Tiger Shark is a large species of ground shark, growing to over 5 m. With a reputation for being 'garbage eaters', these sharks are known to have the widest food spectrum of all sharks.

SCIENTIFIC NAME: *Galeocerdo cuvier*

DIET: Crustaceans, fish, seals, birds, squid, turtles, sea snakes, dolphins, other

sharks, and other man-made objects.

DISTRIBUTION: Circumglobal in tropical and warm temperate oceans.

MAXIMUM SIZE: 5 m

HABITAT: Shelf, reef and slope habitats, often around coral reefs and seagrass beds.
