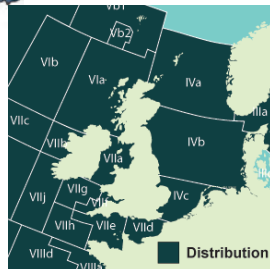


Seasonal –
warmer months.



- 1 Upper caudal lobe greatly elongated, as long as rest of body.
- 2 Large first dorsal and pectoral fins.
- 3 Pointed snout with small, arched mouth.
- 4 Bluish grey to dark grey on top. White below.

Can be confused with
Bigeye Thresher *Alopias superciliosus*.

THRESHER SHARK, Common Thresher Shark, Fox Shark.

From surface to ~650m.

Illegal to target in ICCAT waters. Legal to retain if by-caught.
