SCIENTIFIC NAME: *Carcharhinus falciformis*

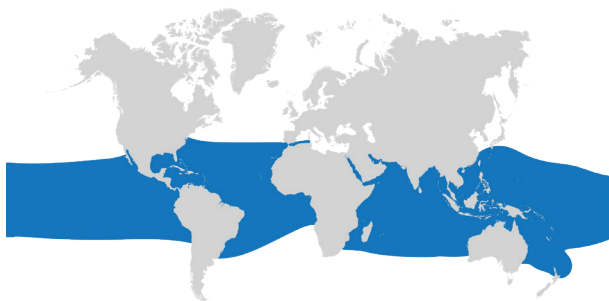
DIET: Bony fish, cephalopods and pelagic crabs.
