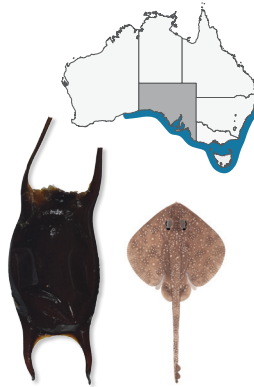

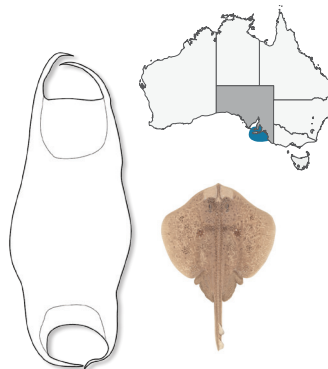
Capsule length: 3-4 cm

Capsule length: 4-6 cm

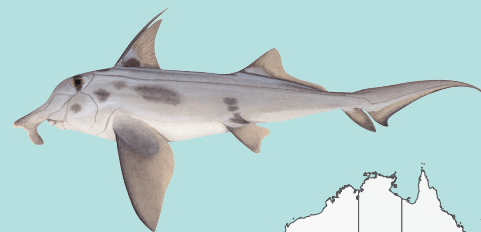


MELBOURNE SKATE

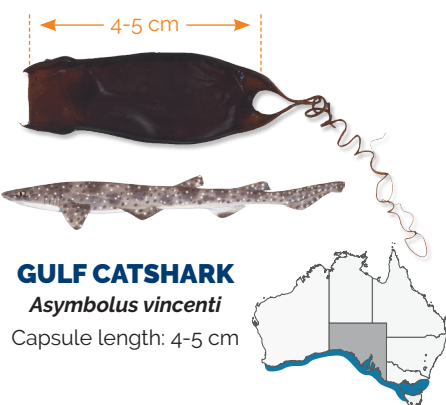

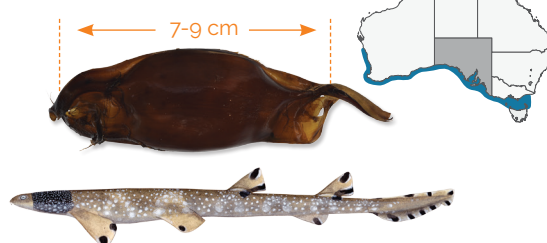


RUSTY CARPETSHARK
