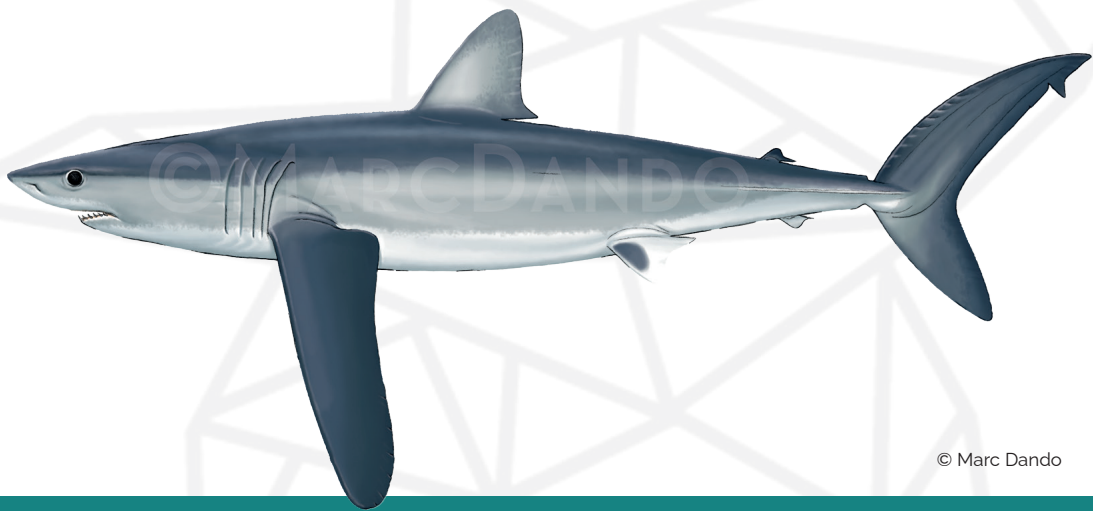




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LONGFIN MAKO SHARK



The Longfin Mako Shark is a majestic and powerful oceanic predator with elongated pectoral fins, and a distinctive, crescent-shaped tail, capable of swift and agile movements in the open waters.

SCIENTIFIC NAME: *Isurus paucus*

DIET: Bony fish and squid.

DISTRIBUTION: Circumglobal in tropical and subtropical seas.

MAXIMUM SIZE: 4.3 m

HABITAT: Pelagic, open ocean, down to 1752 m deep.
