



LARGETOOTH SAWFISH



The Largetooth Sawfish is characterised by its long, flat snout lined with numerous teeth, resembling a saw.

DISTRIBUTION: Atlantic Ocean from West Africa to the Caribbean and the Gulf of Mexico. It also extends into the Indo-Pacific.

SCIENTIFIC NAME: *Pristis pristis*

MAXIMUM SIZE: 3 m

DIET: Benthic crustaceans and other invertebrates.

HABITAT: Shallow coastal waters in tropical, subtropical and warm temperate regions.
