



BLUE SHARK



Blue Sharks are one of the most heavily fished shark on the planet. They are also the most migratory of any species - travelling over 9000 km during their yearly migration.

DISTRIBUTION: Worldwide in temperate and tropical oceanic waters. Possibly the most wide-ranging of any shark species.

SCIENTIFIC NAME: *Prionace glauca*

MAXIMUM SIZE: 3.8 m

DIET: Small fishes and carrion.

HABITAT: 0-1000 m in the open-ocean. Sometimes closer to shores at night.
