



SHORTFIN DEVIL RAY

The Shortfin Devil Ray is characterised by its small size, relatively short cephalic fins, and captivating acrobatic displays as it gracefully glides through the ocean.

SCIENTIFIC NAME: *Mobula kuhlii*

DIET: Swarms of mysid shrimps or larval fish fry.

DISTRIBUTION: Western Indo-Pacific, from East Africa to Northeast Australia.
