



BLONDE RAY



The Blonde Ray has brilliant camouflage against sandy bottoms, hiding it from any predators. It also has small prickly spines all over its dorsal side.

SCIENTIFIC NAME: *Raja brachyura*

DIET: Cephalopods, sandeels, small crustaceans and molluscs.

DISTRIBUTION: Northeast and eastern central Atlantic.

MAXIMUM SIZE: 1.2 m (total length)

HABITAT: Sandy sediments down to roughly 150 m deep.
