The Salmon Shark is a large, fast-swimming shark species found primarily in the cold waters of the North Pacific, often displaying a unique coloration pattern resembling that of a salmon.

DIET: Schooling fishes such as salmon,

herring and sardines.

DISTRIBUTION: North Pacific

MAXIMUM SIZE: 3.5 m

HABITAT: Cool coastal and oceanic waters. Usually down to 300 m but can reach 1864 m.
