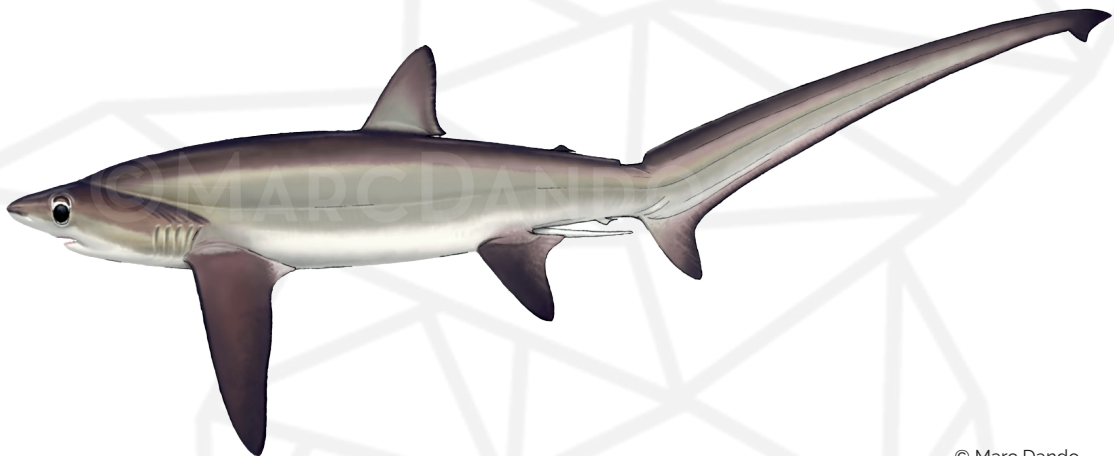

BIGEYE THRESHER SHARK



The Bigeye Thresher is a captivating shark species distinguished by its large eyes, elongated upper lobe of the caudal fin, and hunting technique of stunning prey with powerful tail strikes.

DISTRIBUTION: Circumglobal in tropical and temperate seas.

MAXIMUM SIZE: 4.8 m

SCIENTIFIC NAME: *Alopias superciliosus*

HABITAT: Close inshore to open ocean, down to 955 m.

DIET: Small schooling fishes, cephalopods and crustaceans.
