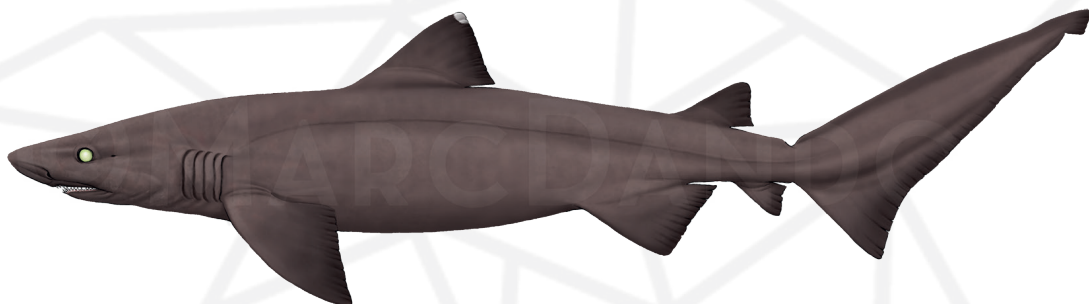

DISTRIBUTION: Atlantic, West Indian and Pacific Oceans. Deep, warm waters.

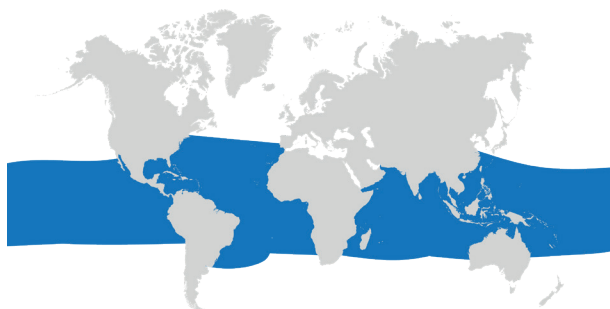
SCIENTIFIC NAME: *Odontaspis noronhai*

MAXIMUM SIZE: 4.2 m

DIET: Bony fishes and cephalopods.

HABITAT: Midwater in the open ocean, near bottom on continental and island slopes down to 1000 m.
