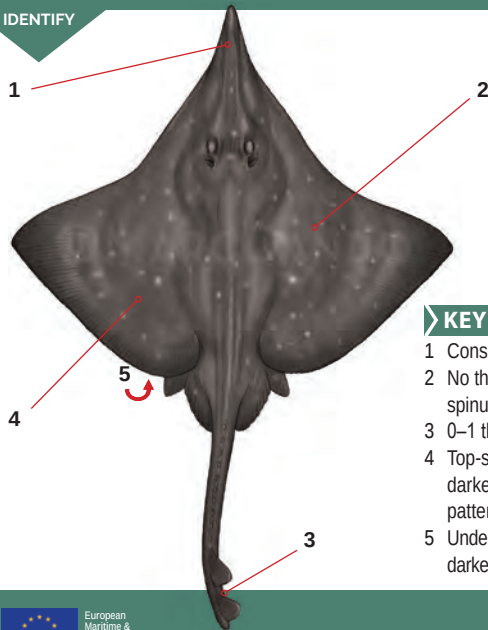


Longnosed Skate

Dipturus oxyrinchus

COMMON NAMES

LONGNOSED SKATE, Sharpnose Skate.

DEPTH RANGE

From 90 to 900m, most commonly ~200m.

MANAGEMENT

Subject to regulations for commercial vessels.

KEY ID FEATURES

- 1 Conspicuously long, pointed snout.
- 2 No thorns on disc but entirely spinulose dorsal surface in adults.
- 3 0–1 thorns between dorsal fins.
- 4 Top-side pale brown, becoming darker brown/grey with growth; with pattern of light and dark spots.
- 5 Under-side pale brown, becoming darker brown to bluish grey with growth.
