



ATLANTIC DEVIL RAY



A smaller species of devil ray, found only along the Western Atlantic coasts and islands. Can range from light brown, to grey or black.

SCIENTIFIC NAME: *Mobula hypostoma*

DIET: Planktonic crustaceans and schooling fishes.

DISTRIBUTION: West Atlantic coasts and islands in tropical and warm temperate waters.

MAXIMUM SIZE: 1.25 m

HABITAT: Pelagic, mainly in coastal waters but sometimes offshore.
